CA Credential Coursework Notes: The above coursework incorporates much of the 600 hours of supervised clinical fieldwork required for a California Teaching Credential. The coursework also includes guidance on a performance assessment (called Ed TPA). A passing score on the Ed TPA is required for the CA Teaching Credential.

Candidates must successfully meet the Subject Matter Requirement to be eligible for a CA Teaching Credential and to be eligible to student teach. Candidates completing the UCLA Math Department's Math for Teaching Major or Subject Matter Waiver Program satisfy this requirement.

Other Notes: Candidates must also successfully complete the CA CBEST test, U.S. Constitution Test and fingerprinting in order to be placed in a classroom and be eligible for a CA Credential.

\*Ed 127/407: An undergrad may elect to complete Ed 127 in Winter of their Junior year (only the course with professor Jaye Darby will satisfy the TEP requirement) or Ed 407 (graduate course equivalent) in Fall of their senior year.

\*\*Ed 107A/406: An undergrad may elect to complete Ed 107A (formerly Ed 130) in Fall of their Junior year or Ed 406 (graduate course equivalent) in Fall of their senior year.
